## **Records of the Northwest Territories and Yukon Branch**

1898-1953, 3.25 m, Accession 82/556

The records of this collection are part of a larger series which was created in Ottawa by a succession of federal agencies that had responsibility for the administration of Northern Canada. The records cover routine administrative matters, and mainly contain police reports on a variety of incidents in Northern communities.

In 1977 these records were shipped in their entirety to Yellowknife, where Yukon material was identified and separated. The Yukon material was shipped to the Yukon Archives towards the end of 1981. The Yukon files were arranged in numerical order, and an inventory was prepared.

Yukon files for the period from 1898 to early 1920's contain some information pertaining to day-to-day management of government personnel, government forms, requests for information, as well as a number of police reports. Files from the mid 1920's on, consist almost entirely of police reports.

It was determined that the Yukon portion of this series should be microfilmed (MF #31) and the originals destroyed on account of the relatively low informational value of the records. Eleven files were kept as sample files and they are located in GOV 1173. Their file numbers are: 2423, 3030, 3077, 3802, 3811, 8899, 13950, 14748, 17569, 19883, and 23494.

The changes in name and function of the federal agencies creating these records can be traced in the National Archives of Canada inventory to Record Group 85, the records of the Northern Affairs Program.

The Introduction to the Finding Aid for the material held by the Northwest Territorial Archives is reproduced as Appendix I.

## APPENDIX I – INTRODUCTION

Introduction to “Files of the Northwest Territories and Yukon Branch (N.W.T. material)”

From 1905 to 1967 the Northwest Territories were governed from Ottawa by a Branch of a Federal Government Department. For the first sixteen years of this period, the population of the Territories was small and the administration minimal. The surviving records for these years are to be found in the Public Archives of Canada at Ottawa in Record Groups 85 (Northern Affairs), 18 (Royal North West Mounted Police) and 22 (Department of the Interior). The files for 1921 to 1953 were transferred to Yellowknife by the Public Archives in April 1977 and are listed here. The files from 1953 onward were moved to Yellowknife in 1967 when it became the capital of the Territories. They will be made accessible at the Archives in due course.

In 1921, as a result of oil discoveries at Norman Wells, the Council of the Northwest Territories was revived, and in the following year a Northwest Territories and Yukon Branch was organized in the Department of the Interior to be responsible for the administration of both Arctic Territories. The Yukon already had its own local administrators in Dawson City and Whitehorse, and a small office was now established at Fort Smith for the Mackenzie District. In 1936 when the Department of the Interior was abolished, the Branch was transferred to the Department of Mines and Resources. It then became the Bureau of the Northwest Territories and Yukon Affairs in the Lands, Parks and Forest Branch. In 1950 its name was changed to the Northwest Territories and Yukon Services in the Lands and Development Services Branch, and then within a few months to Northern Administrations, and to Northern Administration and Lands Branch. In 1953, when the files listed here end, the Branch was transferred to the Department of Northern Affairs. At that time a new filing system was begun.

The cartons of files received from Ottawa were removed to the Archives in 1979, but not unpacked and examined until 1981. They were found to be partly in numerical order and in comparatively good condition. They had not been packed in the cartons with any particular care. Some garbage – inter-office memoranda, draft notes and fragments of file covers and boxes – was removed and destroyed. The files were then re-sorted into their original numerical sequence.

Very large gaps were discovered in the numerical sequence. Some of the gaps were caused by losses and transfers. Some files were transferred to Yellowknife in 1949 (see GFNB 3/94). Others were “brought forward” and assigned new numbers in the same system. A few files from the earlier filing system of the Mines Branch were also brought forward (see GFNB 1/75) and many files were probably transferred to the new Northern Affairs filing system after 1953. “Housekeeping” files of little value (notice of job vacancies, financial vouchers, etc.) were probably destroyed regularly. However, in 1950 and 1951, the Department tried to “accelerate destruction of records” (GFNB 3/203) by assigning extra and senior staff to the task. Most of the gaps in the numbering can probably be attributed to this period.

As received, the cartons contained Yukon Territory as well as Northwest Territories files. Where a file dealt only with Yukon affairs, it has been removed and transferred to the Yukon Archives with the permission of the Dominion Archivist. Other files are concerned with natives in New Quebec, where the same division of the R.C.M.P. was responsible for administration at this period. Some files also relate to public matters in northern Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba. Wood Buffalo Park, which is partly in Alberta and partly in the Territories, was also the responsibility of the

Branch. Finally, there are a few files relating to the royal title, times of sunrise and sunset which have little relevance to Northern Affairs. All these files are listed here.

The filing system established in the newly-formed Branch in 1922 was a simple numerical one. By the time it was closed in 1953 more than 23,000 files had been registered. Each file consists of a sheet of linen of card or foolscap size bearing a printed departmental heading and the file number and a brief description of the subject on the left side. Correspondence was attached to the top left corner of the file cover as received so that it is in approximately reverse chronological order. About half the correspondence filed also has the file number marked on it.

The original numbering system is not strictly chronological for a number of reasons. Some files have been “brought forward” from the previous system and assigned new numbers. This occurred more frequently with Yukon Territory than other files, and often for no obvious reason. Secondly, the uncertainties of northern mail (frequently mentioned in the correspondence on the files) cause considerable delays in transmitting papers to Ottawa. A report might take several months to reach the filing system and if a new file was started for it, it will bear a date several months earlier than surrounding files. It was also the practice to add later papers relating to the period of twenty years or more (e.g. GFNB 1/19).

Until the last years of World War II, the Branch operated an efficient index to these files. This apparently has not survived, but it enabled an earlier file on a person to be identified even when the new business to be added to it was of a completely different nature. For individuals this might be a conviction for drunkenness, the issue of relief rations, or granting an old age pension. From 1944 for several years, the use of temporary wartime staff meant that even the same transaction might have its documents divided between two files. From 1949 onward, the filing system was restored to its previous efficiency.

The information contained in these files related chiefly to individuals and organizations rather than policy. It closely reflects the changes in administrative attitudes during those thirty years. In 1921, local administration was almost entirely in the hands of the R.C.M.P. – the only Federal employees in most of the Territories. With the assistance of Hudson’s Bay Company post managers and missionaries, they dealt with crime, destitution and illness, taxes and probate matters. Other early files mainly relate to personnel in the Ottawa office. Even in 1953 the R.C.M.P. were responsible for much of the administration, but the increased population and amenities had brought about the establishment of some measure of local government, less poverty and more sophisticated types of crime.

Most of the information in the files can be arranged under one of nine main headings:

- (1) Records of criminal investigations and prosecutions. These are usually copies of the police forms, but after 1948 some include the official complaints, depositions and exhibits.
- (2) Records of accidents and missing persons. These are also generally copies of police investigation, but a number originated with inquiries to the Commissioner.
- (3) Applications for naturalization only found on the files for the period before 1939.
- (4) Relief for destitute natives was issued by the police, H.B.C. post managers and missionaries, but each individual case was notified to Ottawa for approval through R.C.M.P. headquarters.

- (5) Between 1939 and 1942 a census of Inuit was conducted by R.C.M.P. posts in the Arctic using (rather inappropriately) prisoner record forms. This was probably the basis for the Eskimo Disc system instituted in 1942.
- (6) Licenses issued by the Territorial Government for
  - a. Engineers operating a steam boiler or pressure vessel (Ordinance, 30 June, 1941).
  - b. Insurance agents (Ordinance, 21 June, 1938).
- (7) The administration of the goods and property of inhabitants who died or were otherwise incapacitated. Although a public administrator (resident in Edmonton) was appointed in 1922, much of the work was carried out by the police.
- (8) Between 1922 and 1939 a few inhabitants of the Territories were liable to pay income tax. Responsibility for arranging payment was also delegated to the police.
- (9) Personnel files relating to headquarters staff in Ottawa until the last few years.

When consulting the files, two problems should be kept in mind. The first is that of location. Many trappers moved about the Territories and settled in isolated places. Some are described as “twenty miles up the Mackenzie river from Aklavik”; others were sufficiently vague as to confuse the contemporary file clerk as well as the modern historians. The other problem is caused by the departmental practice of copying an entire letter rather than extracting the relevant section. Therefore some files contain some information about a wide range of subjects not relevant to the file.

An attempt has been made to include all relevant information in the description of each file. It should be noted that all information enclosed by square brackets is not in the original document, but is based on deduction. The dates given are those of the document in the file and not necessarily the date of the incident described. Where personal names are given these may be of the complainant or victim, or of the accused if it related to a crime. All place names are in the Northwest Territories unless otherwise stated. The standard abbreviations are used for states in the U.S.A. It should also be remembered that the files are not in chronological order. Later records are found mixed with earlier and vice versa.

Although the numerical order of the files has been retained in this list, new numbers have been assigned because of the frequency of the gaps in the old system. At times not more than a twentieth of the original files have been preserved. The original numbers are still occasionally required for use in identifying cross-references on correspondence and have therefore been added in brackets at the end of each entry. Where no number is given, the original number has been lost when files were damaged. The numbers given in the right hand column (e.g. GFNB 1/698) should be used for all reference purposes, and are the only means of identifying the files.
